# MINUTES OF MEETING OF SENNA HILLS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

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A meeting of the Board of Directors of Senna Hills Municipal Utility District, open to the public, was held at 7:00 a.m. on April 14, 2010, at 1502 San Juan Drive, Austin, Texas 78733, pursuant to notice duly given in accordance with law.

### 1. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>

The meeting was called to order.

## 2. <u>ROLL CALL OF DIRECTORS</u>

A roll call of the Directors was taken. The Directors present were Kenneth A. Fox, Gregg Kronenberger and Mike Dansby, thus constituting a quorum. President Chet Palesko and David I. Perl were absent.

Also present at the meeting were Jerri Strain, David Ripley, Bruce Aupperle and Mike Willatt.

#### 3. <u>CITIZEN COMMENTS</u>

There were no citizens present.

#### 4. <u>MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETINGS</u>

Motion was made by Gregg Kronenberger and seconded by Kenneth A. Fox to approve the minutes as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

#### 5. AQUA TEXAS CONTRACT

The terms of the proposed Aqua Texas five-year contract were discussed. No action was taken.

# 6. TAYLOR LAKE EFFLUENT POND AND THE DISTRICT'S EFFLUENT DISPOSAL SYSTEM

### 8. <u>EXPANSION OF THE DISTRICT'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT</u>

Bruce Aupperle reported that he is ready to move forward. He presented a handout that describes the estimated expenditures and the sources of funding. He reminded the Board that chlorine will be the primary disinfection with the UV light as a back-up. The UV disinfection requires sampling five days a week, which is \$10,000 per year. That reduces after the first year to four times per week and then three days per week after that, but is still expensive. After discussion motion was made by Mike Dansby and seconded by Gregg Kronenberger to revise the Application for Bond Issue No. 5 to eliminate the lift station rehabilitation item and to provide \$200,000 for effluent field expansion and rehabilitation. The motion carried unanimously.

# 9. <u>DISTRICT MANAGER'S REPORT AND PAYMENT OF DISTRICT EXPENSES</u> <u>AS PRESENTED BY AQUA TEXAS</u>

David Ripley reported on the District's operations. Jerri Strain presented the District's financial report. Motion was made by Gregg Kronenberger and seconded by Mike Dansby to approve payment of the bills as presented. The motion carried unanimously.
