A meeting of the Board of Directors of Senna Hills MUD was held at 7:10 a.m. on April 24, 2020 by remote access only in accordance with the March 27, 2020 Order by Governor Abbott temporarily suspending certain requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act to advance the goal of limiting face-to-face meetings to slow the spread of COVID-19. The meeting was open to the public and notice was given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act and as modified by the Governor's Order.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order.

2. ROLL CALL OF DIRECTORS

Also present at the meeting were Bill Flickinger and Jeniffer Concienne of Willatt & Flickinger, PLLC, Robert Ferguson of Murfee Engineering, Jesse Kennis, Kristi Hester and Makenzi Scales of Inframark and Allen Douthitt of Bott & Douthitt.

3. <u>CITIZEN COMMENTS</u>

No citizens were present.

4. MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETINGS

President Chet Palesko entertained a motion for approval of the Minutes. Motion was made by David I. Perl and seconded by Lisa McKenzie to approve the Minutes of the March 27, 2020 meeting as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

5. <u>TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON DISCONNECTION OF WATER SERVICE</u> FOR NON-PAYMENT DURING COVID-19 VIRUS CRISIS

Manager Jesse Kennis reported that two connections would have been disconnected on April 21st if the moratorium had not been in place. Lisa McKenzie asked if Inframark has reached out to the two residents, who are tenants, for a payment plan. Manager Kristi Hester advised that they have not reached out to the residents but will do so and offer a three-month payment plan. Mrs. McKenzie also inquired about the security deposit for tenants. Attorney Bill Flickinger advised that the deposit cannot be increased at this time because service was not actually disconnected. After discussion, President Palesko entertained a motion for approval. Motion was made by Corey Newhouse and seconded by Lisa McKenzie to continue the temporary moratorium on disconnection of water service for non-payment until the next regular Board meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

6. PAYMENT PLANS FOR DISTRICT CUSTOMERS DURING COVID-19 VIRUS CRISIS

This item was discussed above.

7. REPORT FROM MR. RIP MILLER ON PROGRESS OF APPROVALS FOR AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE 11.73-ACRE TRACT OWNED BY SENNA HILLS, LTD.

This item was not discussed.

This item was not discussed.

9. ENGINEER'S REPORT ON SOME OR ALL OF THE AGENDA ITEMS

Engineer Robert Ferguson reported that he is continuing to work with Inframark on the operations of the wastewater treatment plant as needed.

10. <u>CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS WITHIN THE DISTRICT, INCLUDING ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS AND APPROVAL, AWARD, RECOMMENDATION, ADMINISTRATION OF CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS, CHANGE ORDERS AND PAY ESTIMATES</u>

This item was not discussed.

11. MS4 PERMIT; MAINTENANCE OF DRAINAGE EASEMENTS AND PONDS

This item was not discussed.

12. <u>BOOKKEEPER'S REPORT, INCLUDING AUTHORIZATION OF PAYMENT OF BILLS; BUILDER DEPOSITS</u>

Bookkeeper Allen Douthitt discussed the updated cash activity report and financials with the Board. The per diem for Joe Szoo will be voided due to his absence. The District's budget is tracking well. After discussion, President Chet Palesko entertained a motion for approval. Motion was made by Corey Newhouse and seconded by David I. Perl to approve invoices, per diems and three fund transfers as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

13. <u>DISTRICT MANAGER'S REPORT ON OPERATIONS</u>

Manager Jesse Kennis discussed his Executive Summary of the Manager's Report.

The activities at the wastewater treatment plant included replacing the chlorine cylinder chains, replacing a sodium hypochlorite transfer pump due to failure, and trimming tree branches off of the back-fence line. Mr. Kennis reported that there has been an increase in flows most likely due to the Stay-At-Home Order. The plant is running at 85% capacity. Mr. Kennis advised however he is not too concerned with the increased flow.

In regard to the re-use water system, the effluent irrigation pump piping will be repainted purple. Mr. Kennis stated that Inframark had to replace a 20-amp breaker for the aerators at the effluent irrigation pond. He recommends upgrading the aerators and electric panel during the pond liner replacement project. The cost to upgrade the aerators and electric panel will be approximately \$16,000 to \$21,000.

Mr. Kennis reported that the District incurred a 9.6% water loss. Inframark will continue to monitor the system. The 2019 Water Quality Report will be issued in June as required. No issues were reported. The report can now be mailed as usual or posted online. After discussion, the Board advised to post the Water Quality Report electronically on the District web site and include language on the June billing regarding the web site posting.

Mr. Kennis discussed the need to trim the tree branches off the perimeter fencing at the lift stations. The District's landscaper, Zane Furr has submitted a quote for that work. Mr. Kennis reported on the enclosure of the auto-dialer at the Lemon Mint lift station. The enclosure has deteriorated and needs to be replaced. Mr. Kennis received two bids for that work. One for \$2,615 and the other \$3,641. After discussion, President Chet Palesko entertained a motion for approval. Motion was made by Lisa McKenzie and seconded by Corey Newhouse to accept the bid from

M&C Electric Inc. for replacement of the enclosure to the auto-dialer at the Lemon Mint lift station in the amount of \$2,615. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Kennis then discussed the need to remove the Roosevelt weeds around the Taylor Lake effluent pond. Zane Furr can remove and haul them off for \$4,000. After discussion, President Palesko entertained a motion for approval. Motion was made by Lisa McKenzie and seconded by David I. Perl to approve the removal of the Roosevelt weeds around the effluent pond, not to exceed \$4,000, which includes hauling them off. The motion carried unanimously.

As previously discussed, the rock gabions at the Indigo Broom outfall have been cleaned up. This will improve the storm water flow in that area. Mr. Kennis stated that the flow line still needs to be cleared.

Mr. Kennis then discussed the CIP Schedule for 2020 with the Board. There are several tasks within the next four months that need to be taken care of. The tasks include meter replacement, fire hydrant repairs/painting, replacing the Lemon Mint enclosure panel, repaving the S curve to the wastewater plant, and upgrading the auto-dialers. The expenditure for those tasks total \$314,000. The Board discussed the \$50,000 price tag for repaving the S curve to the wastewater plant. There was discussion that the expenditure should be a shared cost with Rip Miller and the propane company. Inframark advised that they can send out a letter to the parties once the District receives the actual bid for repaving. This task will need to be put on hold until the spray irrigation field issues are completely fixed.

As previously discussed, the Pios proposal to fix the spray irrigation field came in at \$23,500. Mr. Kennis discussed the nine points of repairs. President Palesko recommended taking a lot of pictures of the site and repairs to include with the documentation for the District's file. Mr. Kennis indicated that a laminated poster size map showing the irrigation zones would be nice to have. Maybe Engineer Robert Ferguson can produce one for the District. Mr. Ferguson will check on the use of a drone for aerial images and see what can be done. After discussion, President Palesko entertained a motion for approval. Motion was made by Lisa McKenzie and seconded by David I. Perl to authorize the repairs to the spray irrigation field by Pios in the amount of \$23,500. The motion carried unanimously. Inframark will oversee the repairs as they are being done.

Mr. Kennis stated that he is still working on a better drum screen process. Inframark has been receiving high water alarms.

The storage unit has been installed at the wastewater treatment plant site and the project is now complete. Mr. Kennis asked that this item be removed from future agendas.

The updated grinder pump letter has been sent out and Mr. Kennis asked that this item also be removed from future agendas.

14. BADGER MASTER METER AGREEMENT (SOFTWARE); PRICING SHEET FOR METER PURCHASE; PURCHASE OF ELECTRONIC METERS

President Chet Palesko reported that they are on track for purchasing 350 meters. Corey Newhouse stated that he has not yet heard back from Jeff Watson at Atlas. Manager Jesse Kennis wanted to be clear that the District decided to just replace the old mechanical meters that are due for replacement under the District's policy at this time, using smart meters without the technology. After the initial purchase, there will only be approximately 70-80 meters left to buy. President Palesko still needs further details on the meters.

15. RATE ORDER

Attorney Bill Flickinger stated that since the District will not be using the technology with the new smart meters, there will be no change to the rate order at this time.

16. BILLING ADJUSTMENTS

This item was not discussed.

Wastewater Treatment Plant and Effluent Irrigation:

<u>Irrigation Control Wiring:</u> The repairs to the irrigation control wiring project was coordinated with an on-site meeting with InfraMark, PIOS (contractor) and MEC where concerns for rerouting the control wires and avoiding conflicts with the proposed perpetual use building easement were discussed. We provided what drawings we had for the older irrigation system layout and the more recent expansion. We understand that the contractor is getting the materials and supplies in preparation of beginning work. We will keep in contact with InfraMark on the progress.

Mapping of Irrigation Fields: Last meeting it was mentioned that it would be a benefit to the operations of the effluent irrigation system to have a map or maps showing the effluent irrigation system complete with lines, valves, controllers and spray heads. We looked into what effort that would take to generate, likely in GIS, a digital record. Our GIS AutoCAD guys made a quick assessment of the existing and available drawings some being old pdf's of original construction drawings, some more recent AutoCAD (irrigation field expansion from 2014) and pdf's of hand mark-ups. Based on the status of the existing information in varying formats, the work effort would entail using manual digitizing lines, valves and spray heads from pdf's, importing line drawings from AutoCAD drawings and making field verifications either on foot or thru drone recording (likely both). The estimate of time to create drawings to combine with available aerial imagery is 50 -75 hours. While we would push down as much of this effort as we can to lower billing level staff, the estimated range of cost for completing this effort is between \$7,000 and \$12,000. This is higher than what I first discussed with Lisa last month but after looking at the effort and time estimates, I am putting this in a little more conservative range as I expect there to be a need for considerable field verification time to make this as accurate as it needs to be.

<u>Plant Operations:</u> We continue to stay in dialogue with InfraMark on the operations of the WWTP and understand the plant operations are doing good (or is it fine, or well, or OK?).

Plant Site Electric Service- Austin Energy: We have asked one of our electrical engineering associates to give us their thoughts on the electric permit situation at the WWTP – that being there are "open" permit(s) at Austin Energy that were not closed out at the end of the WWTP expansion project completed in 2012. This was reviewed a few years ago by an electrical contractor who found that, evidently, the inspections were not performed during construction and he speculated that it probably could be resolved but was not sure how Austin Energy would approach re-reviewing the electrical work after such a long time since construction. This was also identified when Senna Hills LTD applied for a meter installation for their buildings which was denied due, from what I understood, to the open permits. The resulting arrangement evolved into a sub-metering arrangement. I can consult with an electrical contractor familiar with Austin Energy and the electrical engineering firm we've worked with in researching what efforts resolving the open permits may take.

Taylor Lake Pond Liner:

We will bring a proposal for engineering design services to the June meeting for consideration to begin the planning and design of the liner replacement project. We will formulate a project schedule to set the timing of the liner replacement to occur during the hottest time of the summer during the time that storage volume requirements will be at the lowest level allowing for maximizing irrigation application. The planning will involve InfraMark to include operational requirements as well as other improvements, replacements or additions to augment or improve operations.

Site Plans and Development Activity:

We understand the land use plan amendment at the City was approved. We visited with a City staff person about the process of receiving alerts or notices of the filing of a site development permit application and received a link to a GIS system that will facilitate receiving notices of site permit applications filed within a defined geographical area. The link is to a GIS map of the Austin area with permit locations shown graphically. When you click or zoom in on a particular location, it opens a link to the City's website "ABC" where you can access the publically available information directly related to the posted permit. There is not such a noted permit for the office site that I saw for any permit, including an electric permit which I take to mean, there is not an open permit presently existing. This appears to be a useful tool however, the site declares that it is not a "real" time always current site and may have delays in updating information.

Below is a summary of activities since the last board meeting:

1) Wastewater Treatment Plant

- a) 2.47 MG for the month. 82,000 GPD average, 82% capacity.
- b) No excursions.
- The internet cable was never buried by Spectrum.
 I had a crew bury it to avoid damage (330 LF, \$1,100).

2) Re-Use Water System

- a) Treated effluent irrigation pump piping repainted
- b) Zane Furr completed the Roosevelt weed removal.
- Zane Furr trimmed weeds and removed a willow that was growing up around the pond liner perimeter.
 The weeds grow up through seems around the top of the liner.
 He often mows it 2 times a month at \$75 each cut.
- d) Zane Furr trimmed and removed brush from around the pond inspection/leak detection sump, and around the back-fence line of the pond.
- Zane Furr removed and disposed of approximately 300' LF of abandoned PVC pipe along the pond access road that had been there for years.

3) Distribution System - Billing

- a) 3.1 MG purchased for the month
- b) 43.6% water loss. I have initiated a leak detection survey and review of billing reports.
- c) Chlorine residuals and bacteriological samples satisfactory.
- d) 10 delinquent letters mailed out, 0 tags hung, no disconnects.

- f) No formal requests for payment plans or extensions.

- Lift Station # 1 wet well PLC for pump controls is defective and needs replaced.
 Acquiring quotes for replacement.

6) Drainage/Ponds

a) Pond inspection conducted 21 May 2020

WHEREAS, Senna Hills Municipal Utility District of Travis County (the "District") is a political subdivision of the State of Texas, operating pursuant to Chapters 49 and 51 of Texas Water Code (the "Water Code"); and

WHEREAS, the District is required by the Water Code to conduct elections for certain statutorily defined purposes; and

WHEREAS, all elections held within the State of Texas are governed by the procedures set forth in the Texas Election Code (the "Election Code"), except as otherwise noted therein; and

WHEREAS, Section 31.122 of the Election Code requires the secretary of a governing body of a political subdivision to keep his or her office open for election duties for at least three hours each day, during regular office hours, on regular business days during the period (a) beginning not later than the 50th day before the date of each general election of the political subdivision or the third day after the date a special election is ordered by an authority of the political subdivision; and (b) ending not earlier than the 40th day after election day; and

WHEREAS, Section 31.123 of the Election Code provides that, if the Secretary of the governing body of a political subdivision does not maintain an office during the hours and days required by Section 31.122 of the Election Code, the secretary must, subject to the approval of the political subdivision's governing body, appoint another officer or employee of the political subdivision as the secretary's agent to perform the duties set forth in Section 31.123 of the Election Code; and

WHEREAS, the secretary (the "Secretary") of the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board") does not maintain an office during the hours and days required by Section 31.122 of the Election Code and the Board desires to authorize the Secretary of the Board to appoint an agent in accordance with Section 31.123 of the Election Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SENNA HILLS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT OF TRAVIS COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to appoint the attorneys for the District, Willatt & Flickinger, PLLC, as the Secretary's agent to perform the duties set forth in Section 31.123 of the Election Code for each District election, and to post, on the

bulletin board used for posting notice of meetings of the Board, a notice containing the agent's name, the location of the agent's office, the agent's office hours, and duration of the agent's appointment. The notice will remain continuously posted during the minimum period required for maintaining an office under Section 31.122 of the Election Code.

Section 2. A copy of this Resolution will be filed in the official records of the District and will remain in full force and effect and apply to all elections of the District until the Board rescinds or repeals this Resolution or the applicable provisions of the Election Code are repealed or become inapplicable to the District.

Section 3. The meeting at which this Resolution has been considered and adopted was open to the public as required by law, and written notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the meeting, and of the proposed adoption of this Resolution, was given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, and Chapters 49 and 51 of the Water Code. The Board hereby ratifies and confirms the written notice and the contents thereof.
